Call to Order / Welcome

Natalie Kalika called the meeting to order at 7:15 pm

Quorum

15 of 17 teams represented

Treasurer's Report

Annie Pitchford hasn't received the current bank statement. Annie passed around a copy of the financial statement she will be using with whatever information she had. She will have an up-to-date financial statement for the meeting in February, 2011.

Agenda Items

The main item for discussion is the second half schedule, since the next meeting is after the start of the second half. The options for the second half are:

- Option 1: Full round robin, reverse of the first half schedule, will take us to May 12; playoffs would be May 28, with the AGM on June 2, and the banquet June 11.
- Option 2: Divide into 2 sections, 9 teams and 8 teams – starting January 20, section of 9 would play 9 rounds with a bye, and would end March 17; section of 8 would play 7 rounds, finishing March 3.
- Option 3: Divide into 3 sections, 6, 6, 5 – all sections would play 5 rounds. This would allow for 3 rounds of play within each section, starting January 20 and ending April 28. Playoffs would then be May 7, the AGM May 12, and the banquet May 28.
- Gary Pelland brought forward another option. A random draw to be done for the second half with teams being put in a hat and drawn for team number. A schedule of 12 or 13 weeks will then be drawn. As all teams will not be on the bye, the team on the bye will 1 match point and 24 game points.

Motion by Gary Pelland to include the fourth option in the vote, seconded by Wayne Musgrave.

Vote for the second half schedule:

- Option 1 1, declined
- Option 2 0, declined
- Option 3 2, declined
- Option 4 11, unanimous, accepted.

Gary Pelland will do a mock schedule and send to Dave Cripps for review with Natalie Kalika.

180 Pins:

We have run out of 180 pins for the league. Last year, we had 61 people with 180's for the year. The 180 pins are mostly used at our 4 league sanctioned shoots.

These are the numbers that Dale sent from Britcan and are approximate. The website says 10-14 day turnaround.

They advertise free artwork, etc and I see no setup fee on the website but until I send in for an actual quote, I won't know the exact \$ number but I don't expect any more than what the grid says.

Natalie checked with Quality Trophies as well, and the pricing in their catalogues is considerably more, minimum being \$2.00 - \$2.50 per pin at the 300 - 500 mark. And more time is needed. Any thoughts, suggestions?

Motion by Wayne Musgrave to order 1000 1" 180 pins, seconded by Jarrid Missal-Marusiak. Unanimous vote, carried.

Playoffs :

It was suggested that the league consider the breakdown for the playoffs as 5 divisions. Discussion on the breakdown of the league for the playoffs.

Motion by Val Wickenheiser for the breakdown of divisions to be 4, 4, 3, 3, 3. Seconded by Wayne Musgrave. Unanimous vote, carried.

Other Business

Mark Roberts brought the stats entry on the website to the attention of the captains. Most teams are getting the stats entered in a timely manner; however, there seems to be 1 or 2 or 3 teams that don't get their stats entered by the 72 hour deadline. As it was previously discussed that the league would not be putting any "punishment" in place, entering the stats within the 72 hour deadline would be appreciated.
